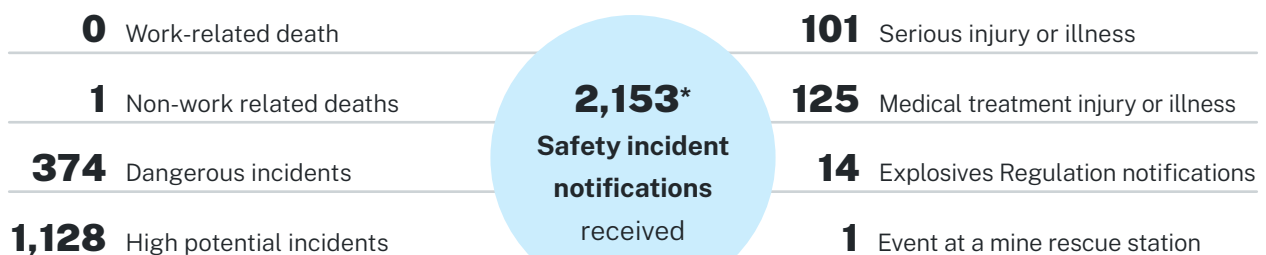
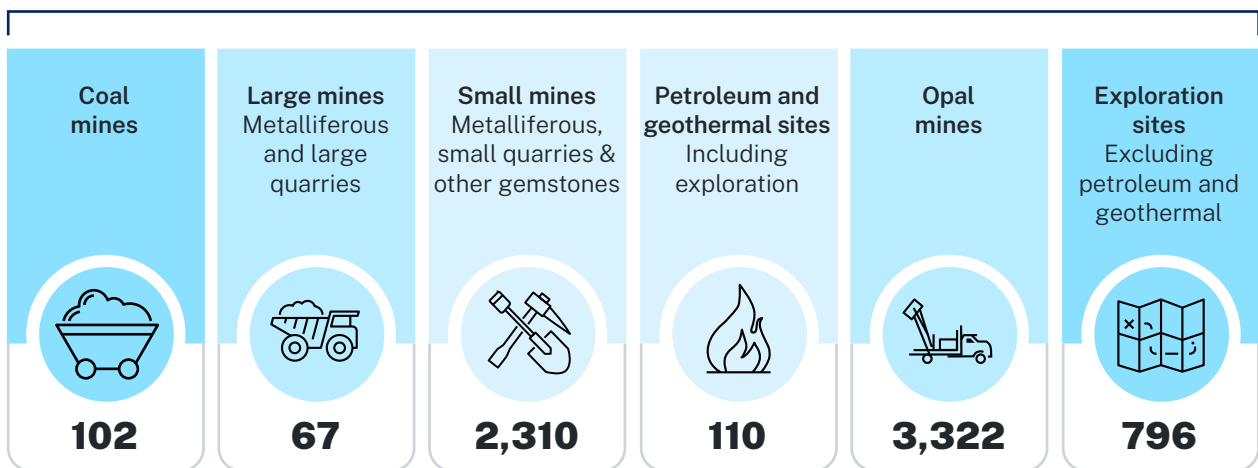

The Resources Regulator regulates safety activities in the following industry sectors.



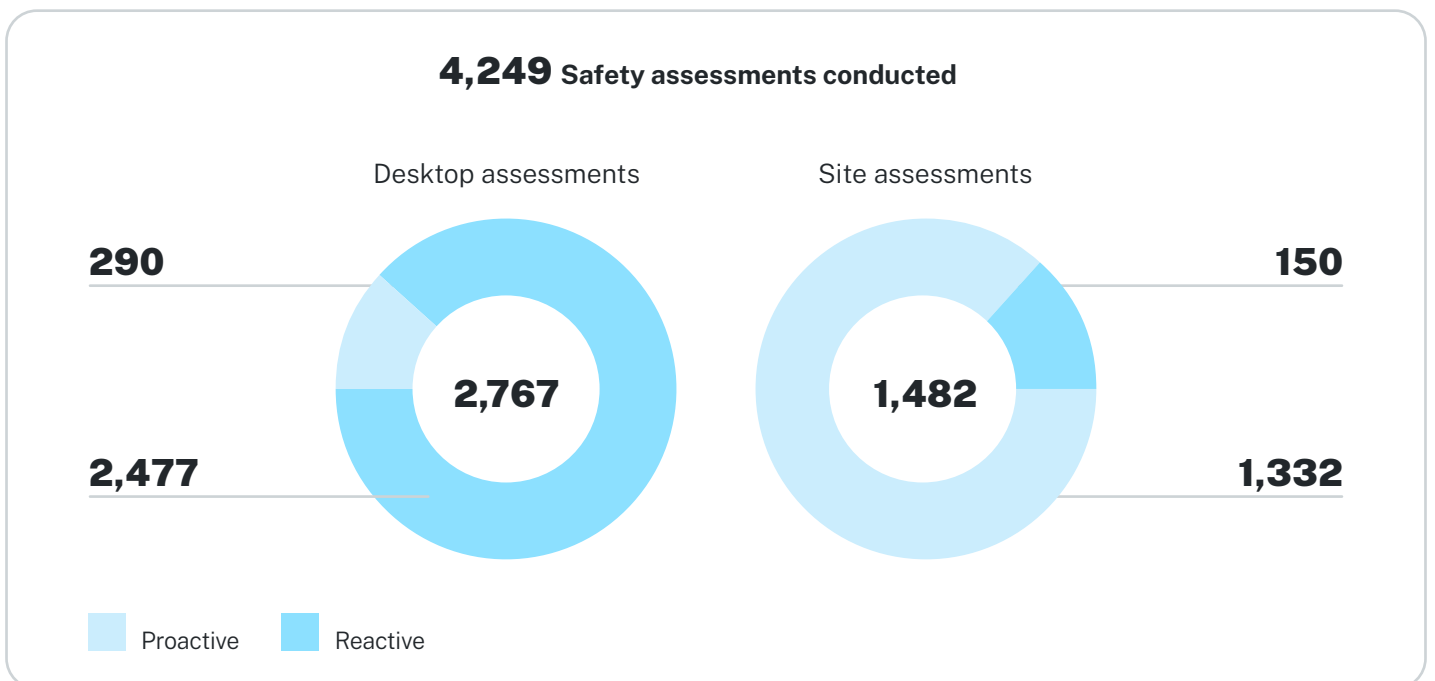
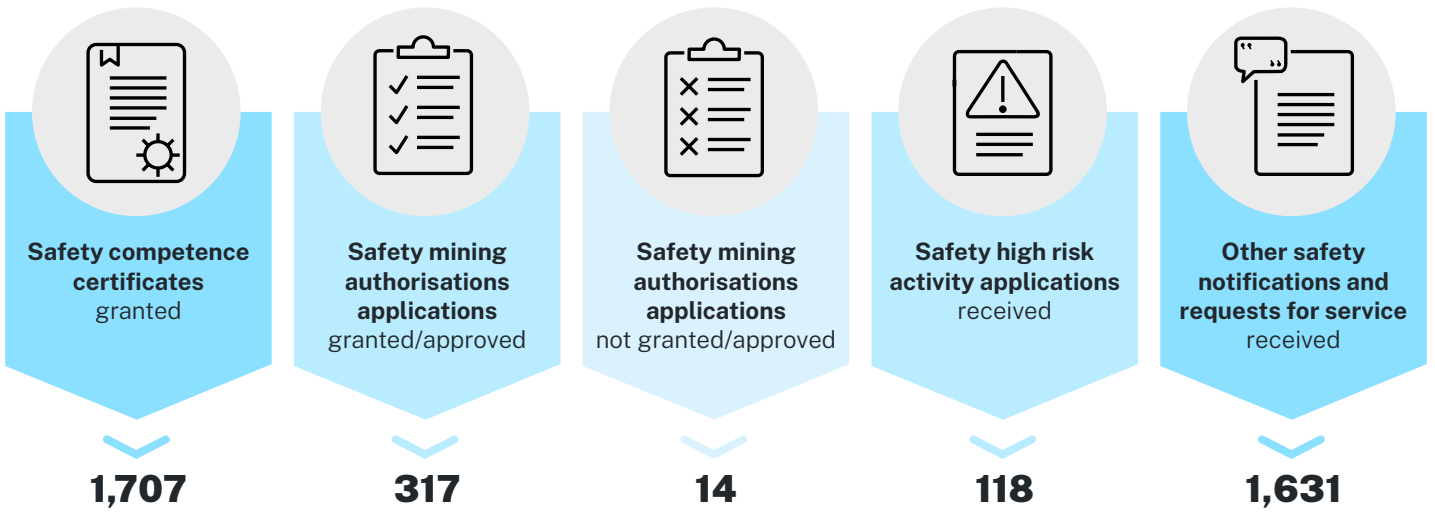

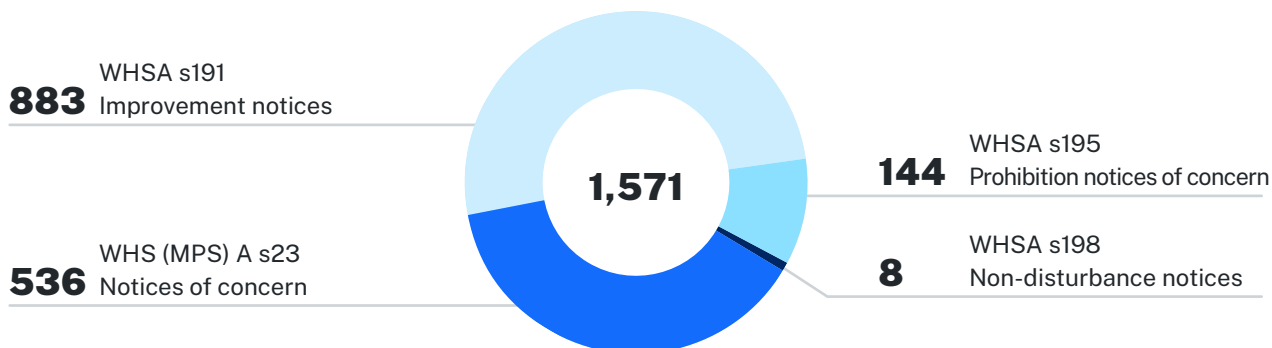

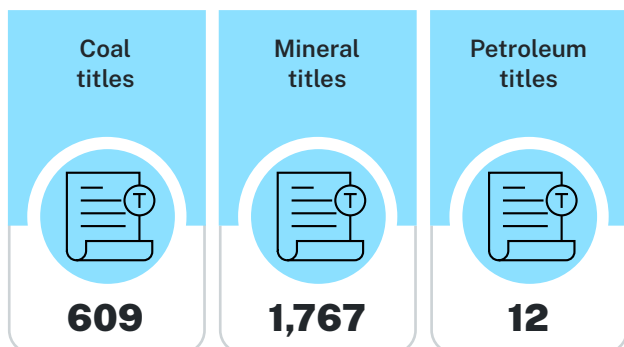

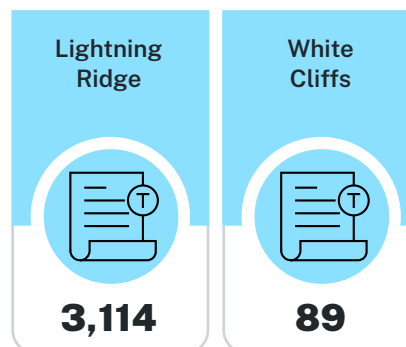
Key Mining Act activities

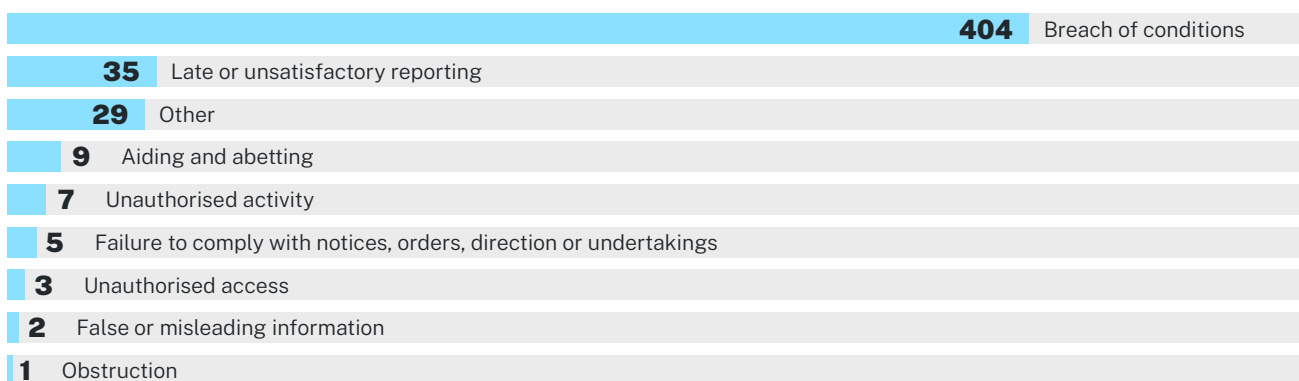
