Key activities

The Resources Regulator undertook a number of major enforcement actions this month.

Prosecution proceedings commenced against Mudgee Stone Co Pty Ltd - a quarry near Oberon in western NSW - and one of its directors. The regulator will allege that unauthorised mining took place at the quarry, located about six kilometres south-east of Oberon. The regulator will also allege that inspectors were hindered in their investigations at the quarry in 2015 when they were prevented access to the site.

Prosecution proceedings also commenced against Ulan Coal Mines Limited and Ulan West Operations Pty Ltd in relation to an incident causing serious injuries at the Ulan West Operations which occurred on 26 November 2015. The regulator alleges that both companies contravened section 32 of the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* by failing to comply with a duty under section 19 of the Act.

In the courts, the local court ordered two Wollongong Coal companies to pay nearly \$40,000 in fines and legal fees for failing to pay required rents and levies. The regulator prosecuted Wollongong Coal Limited and Wongawilli Coal Pty Ltd on three separate charges for failing to pay more than \$288,000 in fees and levies under the *Mining Act 1992*. The two companies have now paid the required rents and levies and have appealed the decision.

Two investigation reports were published this month. One report related to the serious injury of a mine worker at the Mannering Colliery, near Doyalson which occurred on 22 January 2016. The other investigation report related to the serious injury of a worker at the Sibelco Salt Ash Sand Plant, which occurred on 1 February 2016.

Inspectors of electrical engineering held their annual safety seminar on 8 - 9 November 2017 at Sofitel Sydney Wentworth, with 250 people attending, including two inspectors from Queensland attending by invitation. The theme for the seminar was 'Identify, evaluate and control the risks'.

A causal investigation report into the catastrophic failure of a diesel engine system at Wongawilli Colliery near Wollongong was published. The failure, which happened on 4 July 2017, occurred while operating in the underground mine, resulting in the internal engine components being ejected from a cylinder block and being exposed to the mine's atmosphere. Nobody was injured in the incident.
