EXPLANATORY NOTES

This form is to be used by an authorised medical practitioner who is notifying the NSW Department of Primary Industries (DPI) of an adverse health result that is consistent with exposure to a hazardous substance at a coal or mining workplace. Notification of an adverse health result consistent with exposure to a hazardous substance is required under clause 166 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001*.

Hazardous substances for which notification may be required are prescribed in clause 165 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001*.

The *Guideline for Health Surveillance NOHSC: 7039 (1995)* sets out the minimum requirements for health surveillance for each prescribed hazardous substance.
